

COMMUNITY RELATIONSHIP POLICY



At Industria Mecánica Vogt S.A. ("VOGT"), we recognize that being part of the mining value chain also implies a commitment to sustainable development and to building responsible relationships with society. Although we do not carry out extractive operations or generate direct impacts on communities or indigenous peoples, we understand the importance of maintaining a transparent and respectful relationship with our local environment and with society in general, and of collaborating, where appropriate, with joint initiatives alongside customers, partners, and social organizations.

This policy applies to all VOGT operations and our direct employees, including directors, managers, and workers.

We also encourage suppliers, contractors, subcontractors, and strategic partners to share these principles, without this implying direct responsibility on the part of VOGT for their actions or omissions.

This policy also guides our relationship with communities, social organizations, and other stakeholders that interact with VOGT, in line with our other corporate policies.

In developing this policy, we drew inspiration from widely recognized frameworks and guidelines, such as:

- The United Nations Guiding Principles on Business and Human Rights.
- Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), in particular SDG 8 (Decent Work), SDG 12 (Responsible Consumption and Production), and SDG 13 (Climate Action).
- Applicable national legislation, including labor, environmental, free competition, occupational health and safety regulations, and Law No. 20,920 (REP Law).
